

WHAT IS IT?

Launching in September 2019, The Reading Journey is Just Imagine's newly updated resource for supporting independent reading and encouraging reading for pleasure. It comprises a website for teachers and free app for pupils. Available for IOS and Android, the app is a great link between reading at home and at school.

The Reading Journey is a book collection of age-appropriate title selected both for their appeal and quality. These books are recommended for classroom reading corners or school libraries.

An exciting new app, which is free for schools, allows children to create a record of their reading via a personalised bookshelf (even books that are not in the Reading Journey, selections can be added).

A reading journal is built into the app with over 30 fun-but-meaningful challenges that children can select from to record their responses to the books they have read.

Multi-modal features allow children to voice record and add photos to their reading journals.

The teacher interface shows at a glance the children's current reading, as well as their reading history.

The most popular reads for the class are highlighted, providing information that the teacher can capitalise on in Book Talk sessions.

A teacher-pupil messaging facility makes



it possible for teachers to personalise feedback and make recommendations.

The author of the month feature has guest pupil interviewers. Look out for Andy Stanton, Chitra Soundar and Sam Wu creators, Kevin and Katie Tsang.

Plus, a monthly newsletter will provide lots of ideas for making the best use of the multi-faceted app.

The app is available for IOS and Android.

Written by PSTT Fellows Tom Holloway and Ruth Shallcross, Playground Science offers purpose and enjoyment to playtime while supporting learning in science.

The resource provides: • Five drawstring bags:

Navy blue, turquoise, pink, orange and apple green – with space to add a bespoke label to the front of the bag: with the topic, class name, etc.

WHAT ARE THE CREST AWARDS?

CREST Star and SuperStar Awards are an engaging way to bring science to life in your classroom. There are over 100 challenges for KS1 and KS2 available on the CREST website.

tell people what they did.

Even teachers without a science background are encouraged to consider CREST. The website features a section with teaching resources, activities and helpful tips to keep everything running smoothly. CREST Awards are flexible and cost effective. They can be run in schools, clubs or at home.

With no set timetable, passports can be started whenever you want, and take as long as you need.
