Take One Book is a literature-based, process-led approach to teaching reading. It promotes depth of understanding and covers engagement and response, comprehension, fluency, vocabulary and language study. High-quality, short texts cover fiction, poetry and nonfiction. Links are made to science and humanities to help schools integrate reading and writing in subject disciplines.

Writing opportunities run alongside the reading sessions with a series of short and longer writing tasks. Wider



learning opportunities links are also made to the curriculum to make it easier for teachers to integrate reading into subject areas.

Texts are generally short to allow teachers to work with whole texts and provide time for re-reading. Teaching sequences provide between two and six weeks of work, with flexibility to select from the building blocks at each stage.

Half-termly webinars give access to expert training, which can be attended by individual

teachers or used for staff training. Attend live sessions or watch the replays at a time to suit

you. Additional KS1 and KS2 reading training is offered both online and face-to-face for schools.

WHAT IS IT?

A book club format provides time and space for readers to develop sustained reading and deep responses. A subscription gives access to a dedicated website that includes all the resources needed to run the group, including book-by-book guidance, book-specific notes for parents, free online author events, an optional teacher's book group, and a celebratory end-of-year challenge.

Award-winning Reading Gladiators was established by Nikki Gamble and the Just Imagine team, following a two-year DfE funded research project for the London Schools Excellence Fund. Reading Gladiators has been redesigned for current times to take account of the different needs of schools and pupils and is an excellent contribution to a catch-up plan.

It includes a carefully curated selection of books (purchased separately) that are organised to take readers on a journey from more accessible to increasingly sophisticated reading choices. This is achieved through building a community of readers in which high-quality dialogue plays a vital role. The website includes downloadable resources including session-by-session notes and any presentations or handouts needed. And if you want to involve parents and carers, we have some home learning advice with



ideas for building context and sharing books at home. We advise reading six books across the year (one in each half term). An end of year celebration and challenge includes an opportunity for children to share work with other schools.

For the first time, we are including a leader's book group, one for each year group, which will be an opportunity to share ideas and discover more about the upcoming books. Free online author events will be

run throughout the year, giving an opportunity for children to submit questions to some of the

authors that they will have read, in their Reading Gladiator groups, class or wider reading.

The impressively sized 10.4" screen means that it is usable but not cumbersome. Weighing in at 476g, the tablet isn't heavy and is well suited to small hands. The tablet is also great for teachers – it can be stored easily and packs some serious computational punch for its size.
