Algebradabra is a wonderful collection of tasks to use in the classroom, designed to reveal algebraic structure – a crucial aspect of mathematics that learners often find tricky to understand.

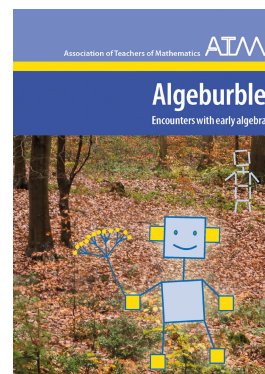
The tasks are given in a variety of engaging contexts, with subtle but crucial variations between the tasks in each set. Inviting and accessible ‘teacher talk’ throughout the book reveals some of the thinking behind the tasks, which are offered as starting points to be modified and extended.

It is highly recommended for all teachers with an interest in enriching learners’ experience of algebra at KS3 and KS4.

Algeburble is suitable for upper KS2 and KS3 learners, and contains a hundred tasks to complete, alongside a flexible commentary that can readily form the basis of a lesson, or sequence of lessons. Alternatively, portions of commentary can simply be used to prompt fresh thinking at the start of a lesson.



Algeburble gives teachers the opportunity to consider what an early algebra curriculum might look like. For example, it could be used to help pupils make the shift



from computational to structural thinking through the use of representations such as tables, number lines and graphs, and potentially the use of letters for numbers.

WHAT IS IT

As part of our commitment to building a more representative and inclusive history curriculum, in late 2020 we announced the addition of a new topic – 'Migrants in Britain, c800-present and Notting Hill, c1948-c1970', to our existing Pearson Edexcel GCSE (9-1) History specification. 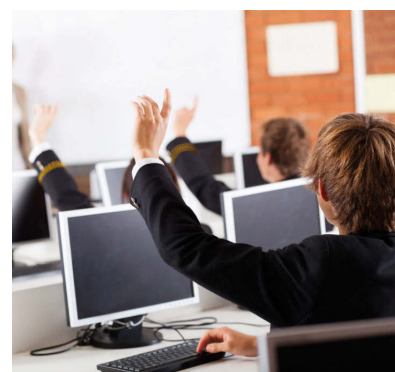

Seamus Heaney once said, *"If you have the words, there's always a chance you'll find a way."* Well, Oxford University Press's new *Get It Right: Boost Your Vocabulary* workbooks are just the ticket, each containing 36 ambitious words chosen to help students read more challenging texts and write with greater confidence and sophistication.

Each book is divided into four chapters, with every focus word presented as a standalone lesson, enabling them to be used flexibly and slot easily into your existing plans. Every chapter employs a unifying theme and focus, such as 'conflict and control', 'mood and tone', 'individual and society', and 'analysis and explanation'.

The structure for each lesson begins with a definition, accompanied by some example sentences and a 'word knowledge' box explaining the word's origins. There then follow three tightly focused activities that aim to help students better understand the word's meaning(s) and explore them further, rounded out with opportunities to use the word in reading and writing contexts.

The activities are all extremely well written and suitably challenging. The books make extensive use of word webs, grids and tables, sentence completion exercises (with answers accessed online), reading extracts and writing tasks, yet still comes across as short and snappy. Rather than overwhelming or overloading learners, they instead serve to empower and motivate.

Oracy activists will meanwhile be pleased to see the inclusion of 'Have your say' sections

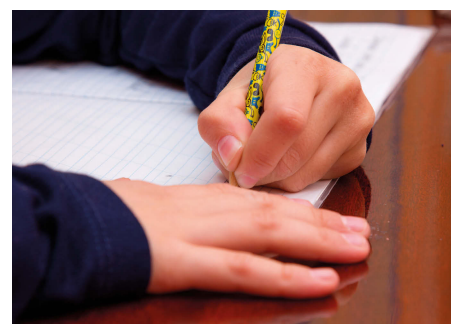
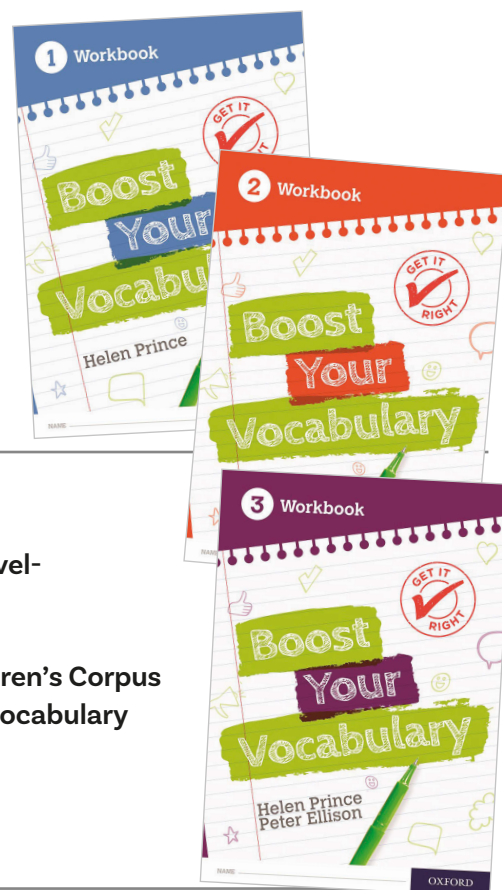
within each chapter, which can be used as springboards for lively classroom discussion and debate. These give students plenty of opportunities to air their thinking, justify their reasoning and use the focus words they're learning about with precision and flair.

Students will also find dotted throughout the books a series of useful tips to assist with completing the activities, plus a 'key terms' glossary at the back that defines the key literary and linguistic terms appearing in each chapter.

A concluding word list in each book then brings together all the definitions of the synonyms and antonyms used in the preceding chapters.

Layout and graphics are crucial to any workbook's success, and the *Get It Right: Boost Your Vocabulary* certainly succeeds in this respect. The design throughout is colourful, inviting and very user-friendly. Taken together, these workbooks amount to a do-it-yourself word power programme, helping students speak and write with more confidence, master ambitious words, increase their knowledge and build a more impressive vocabulary.

The *Get It Right: Boost Your Vocabulary* workbooks support learning across the curriculum and can help students get a firmer foothold in almost every subject they're likely to encounter at school. These workbooks will help students to be more bold and courageous in their word use, and show them just how rewarding discovering and learning new words can be.

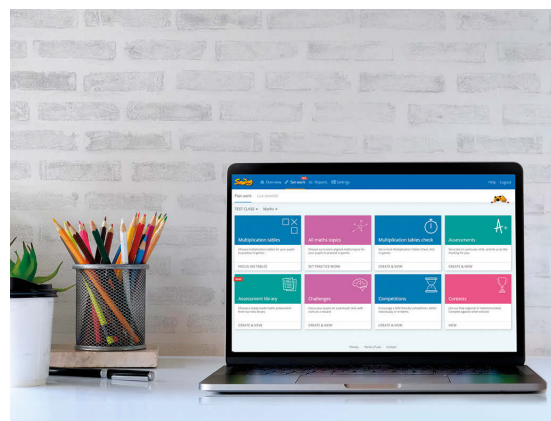

There's been a steady stream of research pointing to the potential for games to serve as a useful instrument in maths education. Sumdog aims to put this into practice, and in the process, accelerate students' maths growth, rapidly develop their fluency and build their confidence.

Studies have shown that with regular use, Sumdog does indeed have a high impact on learners, and that's the key – repetition. Sumdog is specifically constructed so that learning is reinforced by alternating and revisiting topics, thus strengthening pupils' fluency.

Students will, however, quickly become reluctant to repeat experiences if they're not enjoyable, but this is where Sumdog excels, by providing highly motivating games that students keep wanting to play.
