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How it worked

We invited nominations from product specialists, publishers and service providers via an online form, Teach Company staff then proceeded to assemble shortlists for each category from the entries received. These shortlists were subsequently passed on to our judges with accompanying review copies, product samples and online logins, where applicable.

The judges were directed to assess each entry according to a set of category-specific criteria – albeit with some common considerations, including impact on academic outcomes, ease of implementation, adaptability and value for money. When returning their verdicts the judges indicated to us their choice of overall winner, together with two highly commended entries.
