Little Pig Big Chicken

Rent-a-Pig Programme providing all you need to keep two mini-pigs at school for a week.

WHO WE ARE

Little Pig Big Chicken is a small family farm in the East Sussex Countryside that breeds miniature pigs. Many of its piglets go on to be countryside family pets, but in cities where space is limited, farm animals are harder to come by.

Now in its third year, its 'Rent a Pig' Programme has provided a unique learning experience to schools all over London and as far as Sheffield, Birmingham and Manchester.

Pigs spend a week at your school – often Sunday to Saturday, but weekday drop offs can be arranged if required.

All pig-movement licensing is taken care of for you and risk-assessment templates are available if required. This service is fully insured.

Rent a Pig is a powerful tool for teaching empathy and responsibility in pupils of all ages. Those who struggle to concentrate in lessons can find activities involving animals aid their focus. Children learn about animal husbandry and animal welfare on farms, and for young children or those with limited mobility animal experiences with miniature pigs can provide a safe way to interact fully with a farm animal.

(Details in the 'Government Response To The Consultation On 'Transforming Children And Young People's Mental Health Provision: A Green Paper' And Next Steps' and the All Party Parliament Group for a Fit and Healthy Childhood's 'Mental Health in Childhood' report.)

However, it is highly likely that prescribed standards will have to be met to obtain the funding.

There are two key questions:

Registration: Is your school using therapists who are registered with a Professional Standards Authority (PSA) Accredited Register or with the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC)? It will no longer be acceptable for unqualified, inadequately trained persons without clinical supervision to be employed or contracted to carry out this work.

Evidence-based practice: Are the practitioners using a therapy model that is backed by a quantified evidence base?



Current guidelines recommending children should be active for one hour a day, with 30 minutes of this being at school, is increasing pressure on schools to provide physical activity.

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
